them.






Confess your sins daily:

"All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out."



Security of Salvation



Security of salvation is based on the biblical *fact* that once the gift of salvation has been received, it is possessed forever and cannot be lost!

Assurance of Salvation



Assurance of salvation is based upon my *feeling* or my level of confidence that God did what He said He would do when I believed in Jesus.

Understanding Two Truths

Your *feelings* may change from day to day, but that does not change the *fact* that God saves all who believe on Jesus.
