



Hearts Review Game

Prepare this game by cutting out the large heart and covering it front and back with clear contact paper. Hang it on your white board so the class can see it.

To play the game, choose two teams. Ask a review question from your lesson. The child who stands first and gives the correct answer gets to come to the front. Blindfold him and give him a **nonpermanent** transparency pen. Let him put his initials in the big heart. Wherever his initials land, he gets that many heart candies for himself and that many points for his team. If his initials do not land in any heart, he gets zero candies and points for his team. Continue asking questions in this way. The team that has the most points wins the game!
