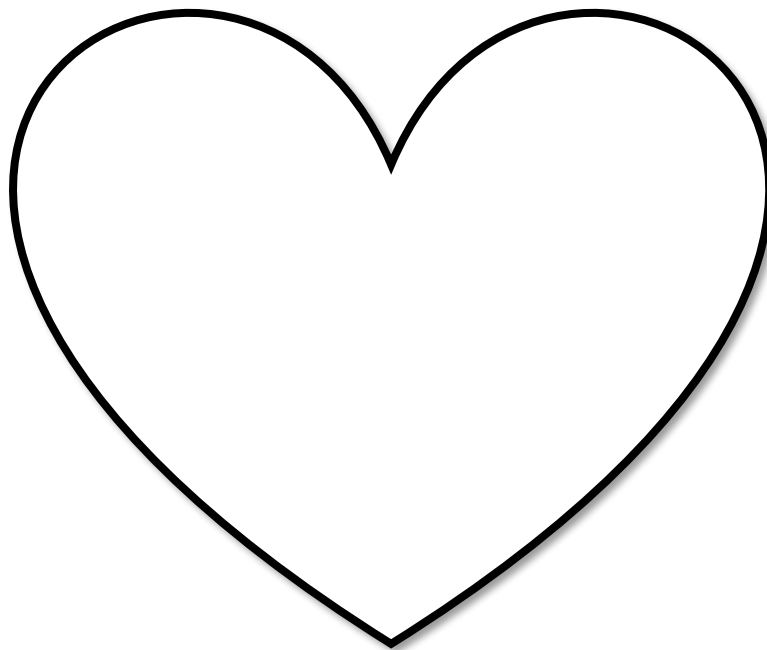
Who Should Confess their Sin?
