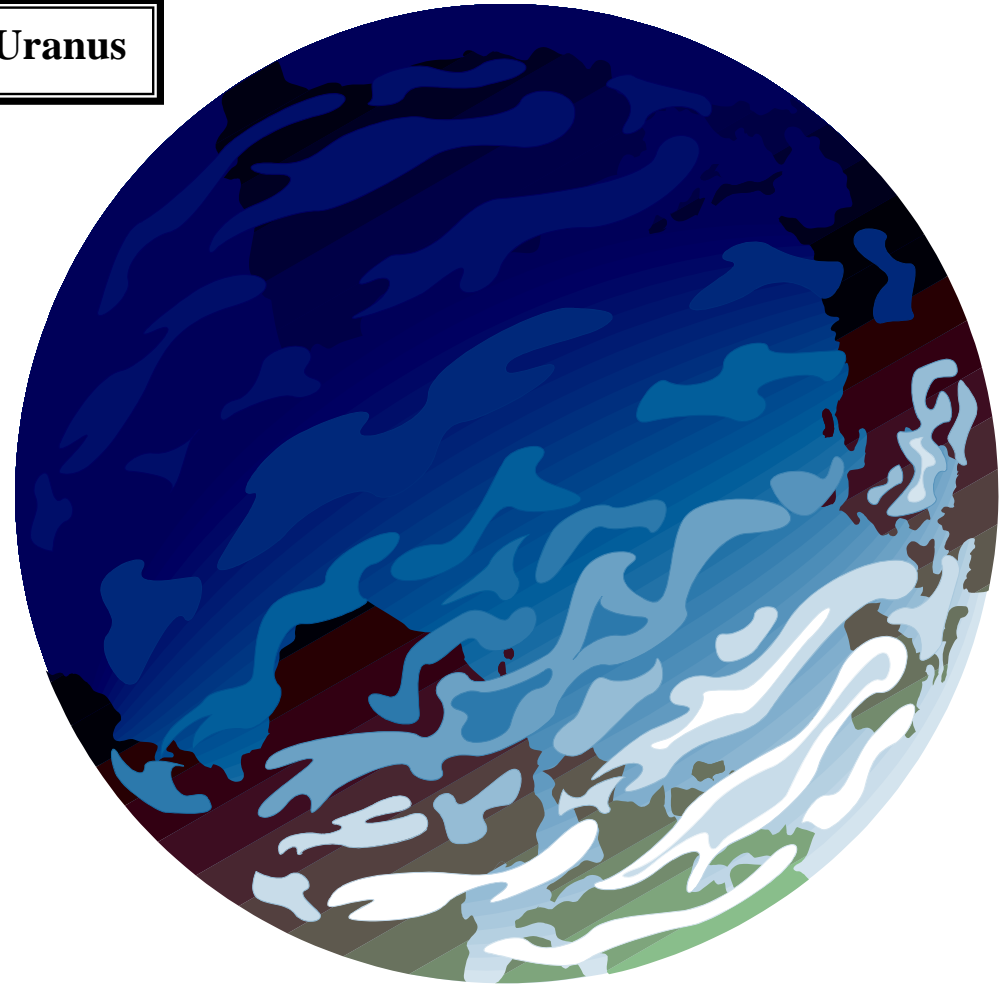


6. Uranus



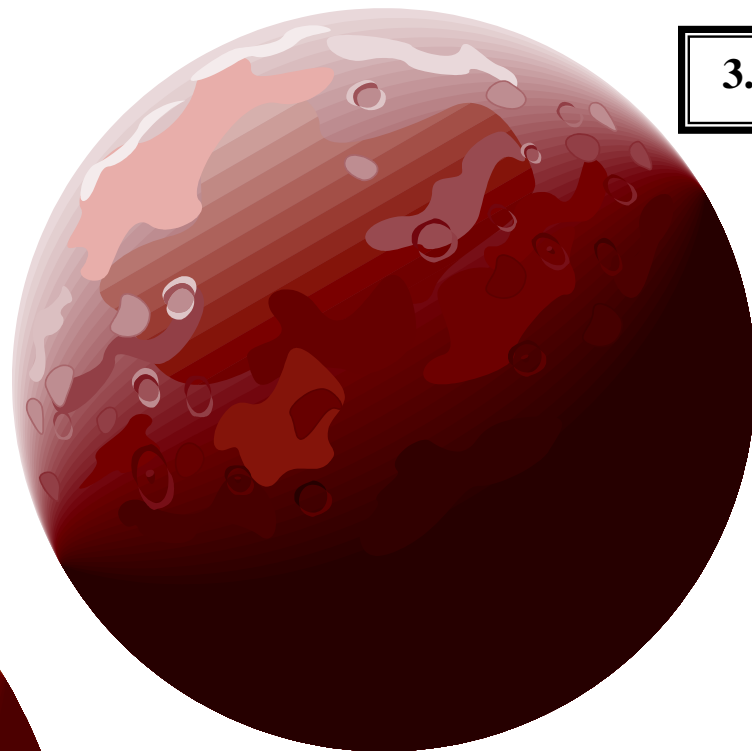
Race to the Moon

To prepare this review game, cut out all of the figures. Glue the names of the planets onto the back of them. Cover with clear contact paper. Place a magnet on the back of each.

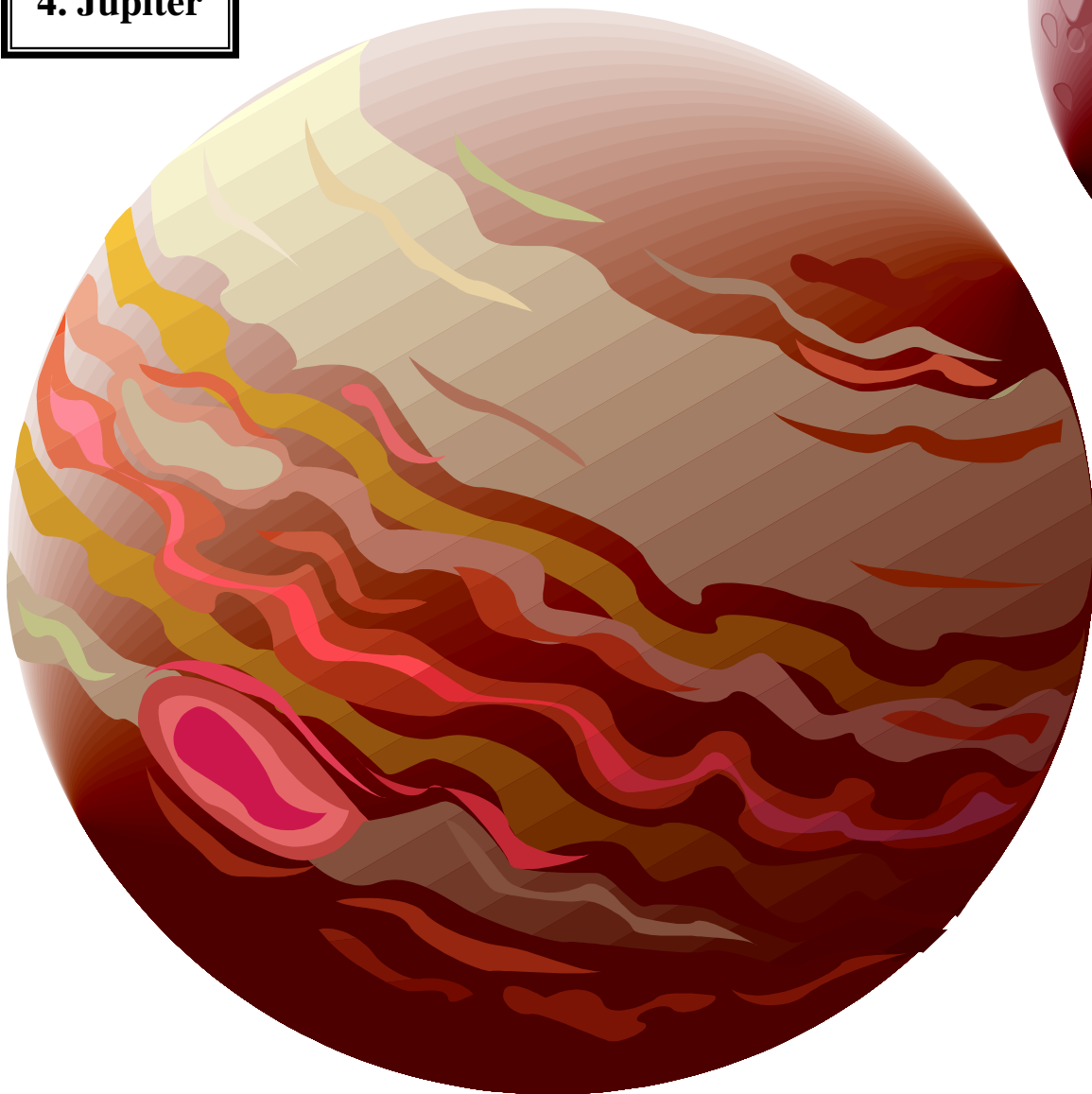
Place the planets #1-#8 vertically on a metal surface (#1 at the bottom and #8 at the top). Put the astronauts (or spaceships) at the bottom. Explain that the last astronauts that went to the moon left their lunar rover there by accident. These astronauts have been sent to get it.

Divide the class into two teams and assign them an astronaut (or spaceship). Have review questions written on pieces of paper and a (1) or (2) after the question. Choose one question and tell the class how many planets the astronaut can move up for the child who gives the correct answer. Read the question. The child who stands and answers correctly gets to move his team's astronaut up the number of planets that his paper said. See which team can get his astronaut (or spaceship) to the moon first.

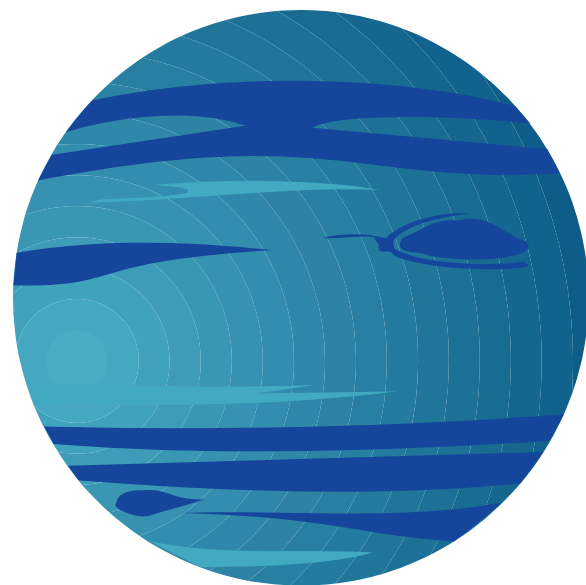

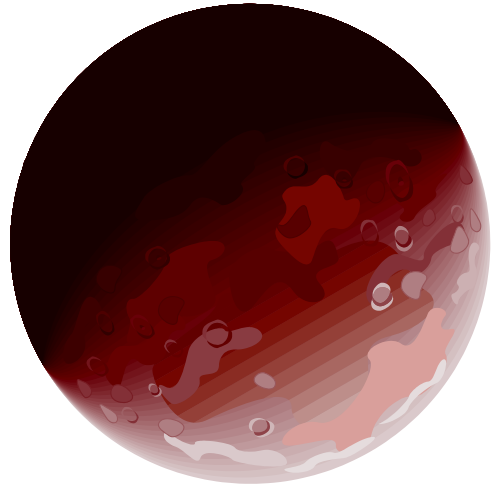
4. Jupiter



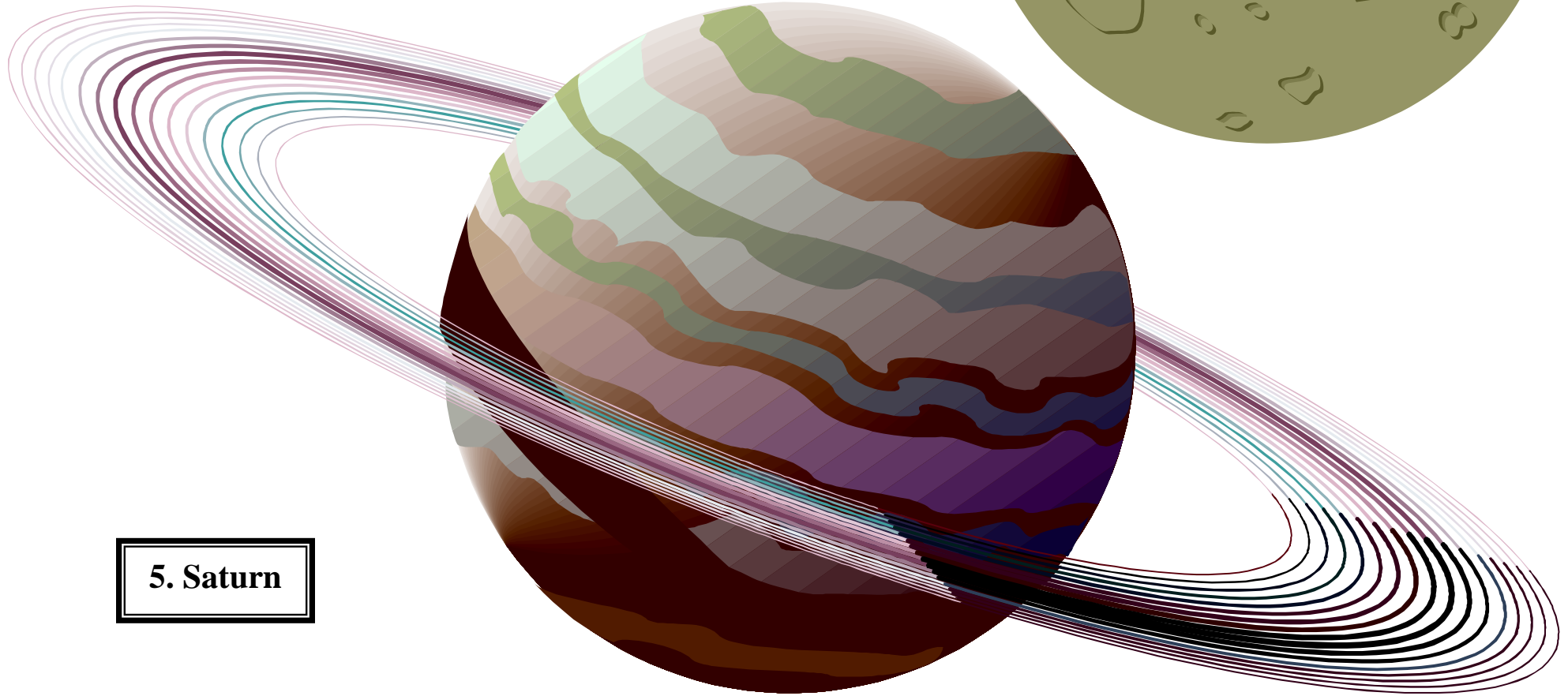
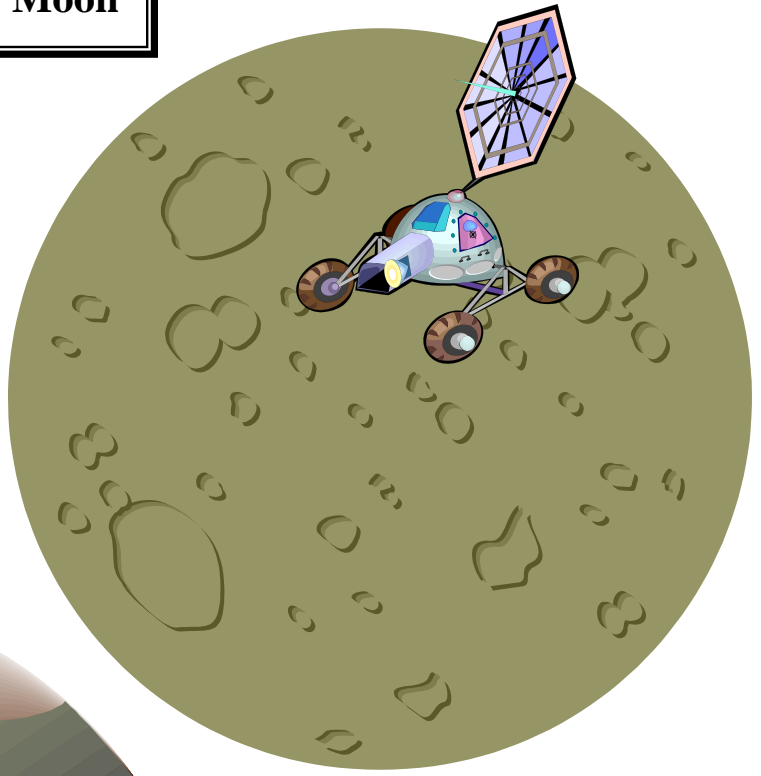

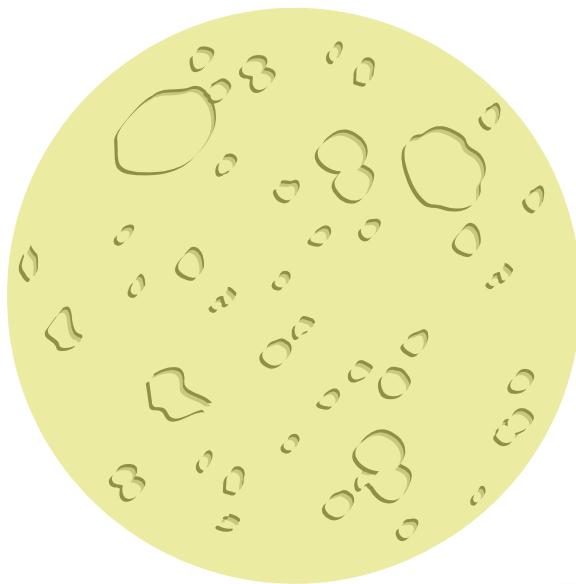
