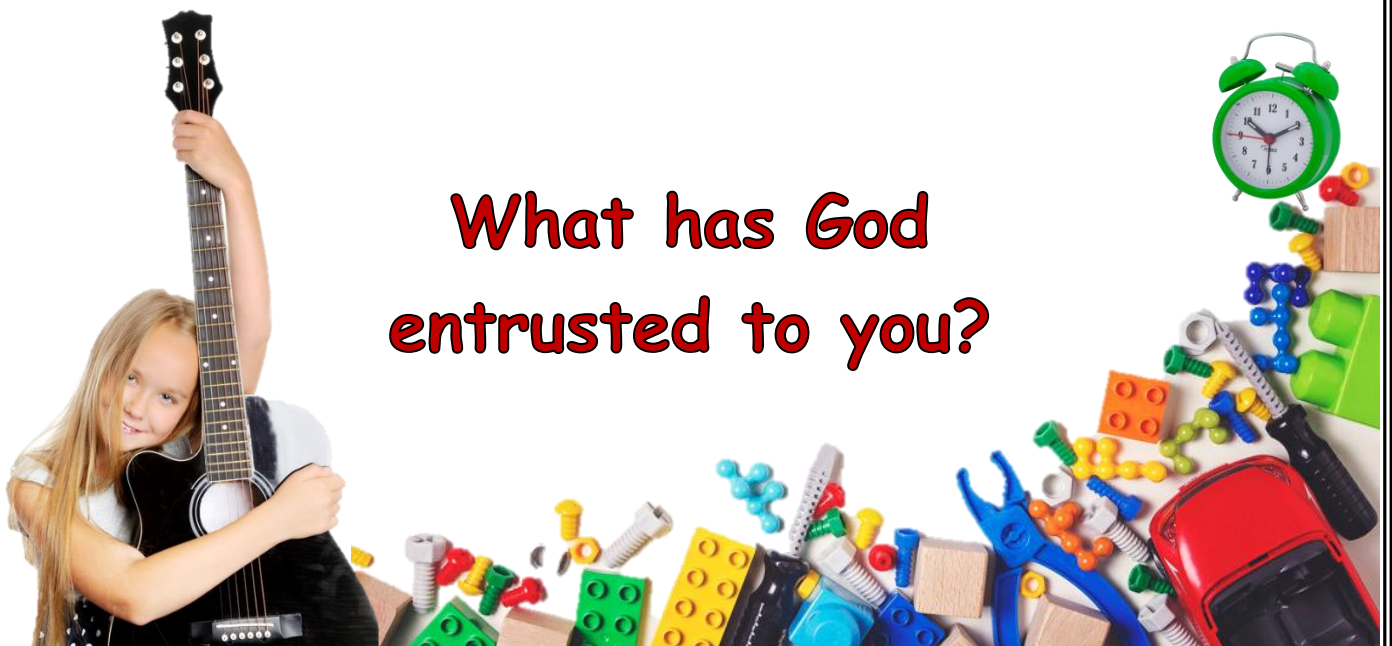

What is Christian Stewardship?

"Christian stewardship is recognizing that everything that I have really belongs to God, and that I am responsible to take care of it and use it as He would want me to. It also includes the idea that I need to give back some of what He has entrusted me with to those who serve Him and to help others who are in need."

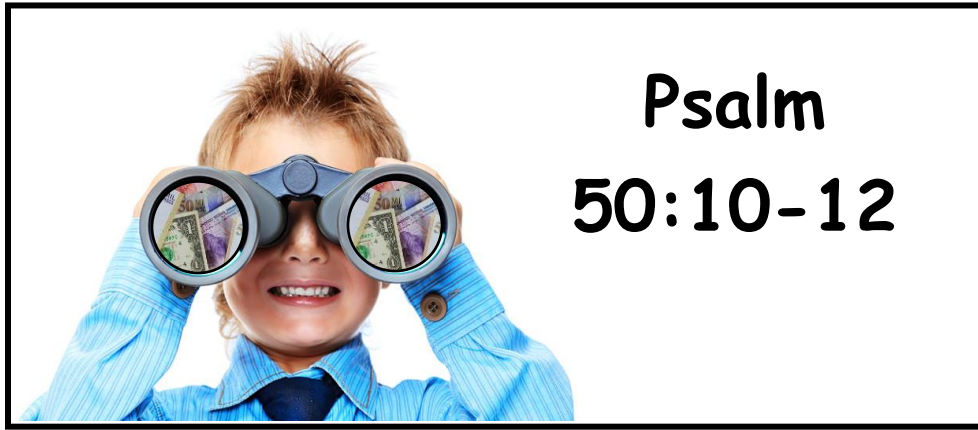
