





Target

To prepare the game, glue one page of targets on pink paper. Glue the other page of targets on blue paper. Cut all of them out and cover them with clear contact paper. Put a magnet on the back of each (on the pink or blue side) if you have a magnetic white board. You can also tape them to the wall.

To play the game, put the target circles on the wall or board (target side facing the class). Divide the class into a girls' team and a boys' team. Ask a review question. Give the child who raises his hand first and answers correctly a laser light to point to one of the targets (or if you don't have a laser light, let him point with his finger). Turn the circle over. If a boy has chosen a blue circle, the boys' team gets 100 points. If a girl has chosen a pink circle, the girls' team gets 100 points. But if a boy gets a pink circle, the boys give 100 points to the girls' team. If a girl gets a blue circle, her team gives 100 points to the boys' team. At the end of the game, the team with the most points wins!
